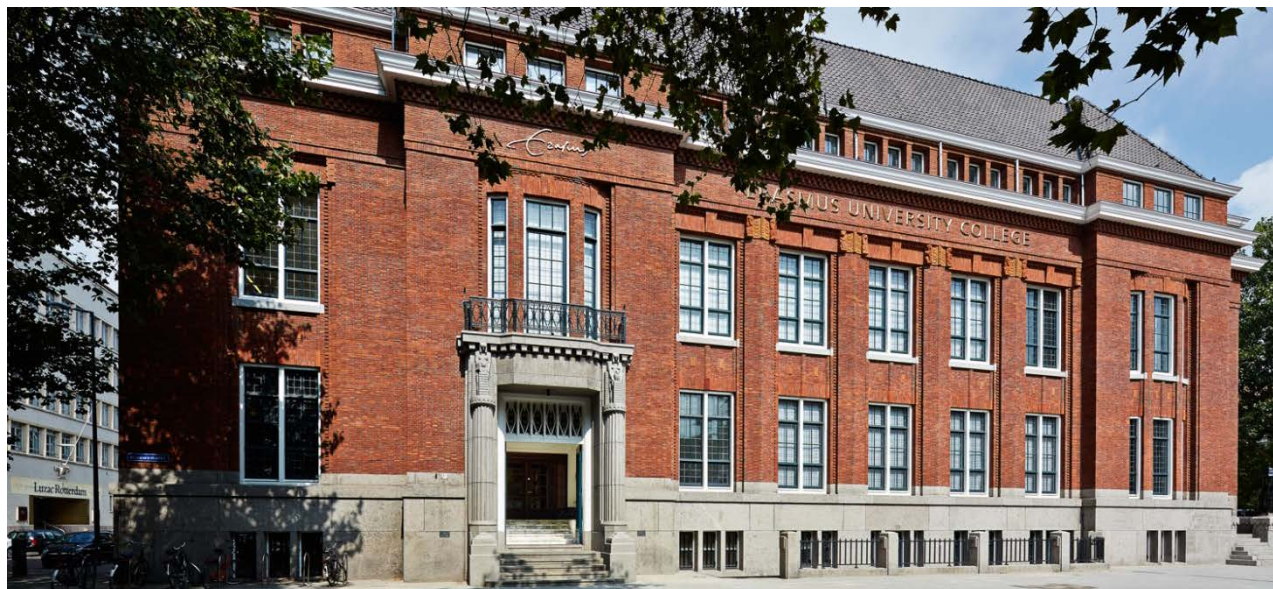


## EXCHANGE PARTNERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

<b>About the University</b>	Founded in 2013, Erasmus University College is part of Erasmus University Rotterdam and is located in the city center of Rotterdam—the second largest city of the Netherlands. The institution currently has less than 1000 students and offers an international undergraduate program with courses in Humanities, Social & Behavioral Sciences, Life Sciences and Economic & Business.
<b>Who can apply?</b>	Undergraduate or Graduate students.
<b>Program Dates</b>	<u>Semester 1</u> : September – January (Quad 1 & Quad 2) <u>Semester 2</u> : January – June (Quad 3 & Quad 4)

<b>Language(s) of Teaching</b>	Courses are taught in Dutch and English.
<b>Credits Required</b>	In the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), the normal workload for a full-time student is 30 credits per semester. It is recommended exchange students to take a minimum of 20 credits.

<p><b>Accommodations</b></p>	<p><b>Student housing in the Netherlands is not arranged for you by the university;</b> it is your own responsibility. Most students arrange housing directly with landlords via the private market. <p><b>Costs</b></p>	<p><b>Average Monthly Living Expenses:</b></p> <p>Accommodation (furnished, including shared or individual utilities): €500-€600 or €25 in The Student Hotel</p> <p>Study Costs (books etc.): €65</p> <p>Visa and Residence Permit: €307 (non-EU residents) onetime payment</p> <p>EUCSA membership: €25 for 1 semester</p> <p>Personal Expenses (food, drinks, clothes, going out, public transport, etc.): €300-€500</p>
