How?

100 points of experience and then participation in a workshop are required to be awarded the Honor.

You can earn points in four different ways:

- Complete an internationally or interculturally focused volunteer or internship placement either at home or abroad
- Study a foreign language, or earn points for preexisting foreign language skills
- Study, work or complete research abroad during your Western degree

 Attend the workshop in Global and Intercultural Competency through Western International

Did you know?

- You do not need to leave the country to be awarded the Honor.
- You do not need foreign language skills to be awarded the Honor.
- There is no registration deadline. You can submit your Honor claim up until the end of your final term.
- A dynamic point system offers flexibility in *how* you earn the Honor.
- As an international student, you can claim English proficiency if it is your second language, as well as your time studying in Canada.
