<b>Language(s) of teaching</b>	Courses are taught in English.

<b>Credits required</b>	In the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), the normal workload for a full-time student is 30 credits per semester.
<b>Accommodations</b>	Generally, 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> year students study and live at the Richmond Hill Campus and 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> year students study and live at the Kensington Campus.
