SFS Office Hours: Gradual Re-Opening

Parking Passes:

King's Parking Passes for the upcoming Fall/Winter term will be **available** for sale online July 1, 2020. Please note that guaranteed parking space on campus is limited and passes are sold on a first come, first serve basis. Passes will be available for pick up after August 15, 2020.

OSAP:

The 2020-2021 OSAP application is now available online at https://osap.gov.on.ca/OSAPPortal/index.htm. Students who intend on using OSAP funds to pay their fees for this upcoming September must complete the online application by *June* 30th and have all supporting documentation submitted by July 15th. Students can still apply after this date, however processing times can range from 6-8 weeks.

Hints when applying under the full-time program:

- You will be asked for your OAN (Ontario Access Number) and Password when logging in
 - o If you have forgotten either of these, please visit https://osap.gov.on.ca/OSAPSecurityWeb/public/retrieve_oan.xhtml for assistance.
 - o If you are still unable to retrieve your OAN and/or password, please come into Student Financial Services at King's (or any post-Secondary institution that administers OSAP) with your SIN card and valid government-issued photo ID. We can retrieve your OAN and/or issue a temporary password. Please see above for office hours. In the short term, you may also request a telephone appointment for OAN and password retrieval. Please email studentfinance@kings.uwo.ca to arrange an appointment.
- Select Western University Canada as your institution and then select a King's program from the existing list.
- If you plan to be in a blended course load with online and in class courses select "no" to the online/distance only question. This can be updated if you find after course enrolment that you are in strictly online courses
