<b>About the university</b>	<p>Université Catholique de Lille is a multidisciplinary university with 6 Faculties, 20 "Grandes Ecoles" and vocational colleges in 4 major fields of study :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Law, Economics and Management</li> <li>• Sciences and Engineering</li> <li>• Arts and Humanities, Theology, Ethics</li> <li>• Health Sciences and Social Work</li> </ul> <p>They host 24,540 full time students, of which 1,900 are international students who come from 88 different countries</p>
<b>Who can apply?</b>	Undergraduate students Students are selected by King's University College.
<b>Program dates</b>	<p>The academic year is divided into 2 semesters</p> <p>In the faculties :</p> <p>Fall semester: From early September to December or January Spring semester: From January to May or June</p> <p>Each faculty and each school has its own academic calendar</p>
<b>Language(s) of teaching</b>	Most of courses are taught in French. Some are taught in English, German and Spanish
<b>Credits required</b>	<p>In the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), the normal workload for a full-time student is 30 credits per semester.</p> <p>It is recommended that exchange students take a minimum of 20 credits.</p> <p>Courses must be approved by the King's Office of the Academic Dean.</p>
<b>Courses offered</b>	Exchange students can take courses on Lille Campus offered in any of the major fields of study including the faculties of: Law, Economics and Management, Arts and Humanities, Medicine, Science and Technology, Theology, Social Work, and the College of Communication.
<b>Accommodation</b>	University dorms are available on campus and off-campus housing is available through AEU (Housing Office).
<b>Costs</b>	<p>Average monthly costs: 805 - 948 Euros (approximately \$1100 - \$1300 CAD)</p> <p>Other expenses: French Health insurance: About 200 Euros/Academic year. It is mandatory if students stay for more than 3 months in France</p> <p>AEU housing deposit: About 595 Euros. It will be returned at the end of the year if no material damage has been caused to the room</p>
<b>Application deadlines</b>	Spring semester: October 15, Fall semester: April 30
