

## **Course Types for Fall 2020**



**Asynchronous**: something that can be viewed "on-demand". An example of this would be a recorded lecture, a YouTube video, or a Netflix movie.

**Synchronous**: Something that occurs at the same time or "live". An example of this would be a music concert, a class lecture delivered in-person or online at a specified date and time, or a scheduled TV show.

	A <b>synchronous</b> course, where all aspects of the course are delivered in person	A <b>predominately online</b> course, where most aspects of the course are delivered via OWL, however, some course content, could be offered either in-person or synchronously online	An <b>asynchronous</b> course, where all aspects of the course material, activities, and assignments are completed online via OWL. Optional synchronous elements may be offered

Timing of Delivery	<b>Required*</b> : synchronous  *Instructors may decide not to require attendance and/or explicit participation	Required*: synchronous (i.e. students are required to keep timeslot reserved)  *Instructors may decide to not require participation/attendance for all synchronous components. This will be clearly articulated in the course outline	Required*: asynchronous Optional: synchronous components  *Students are not committed to a specific day and time, but instructors may offer participation in non-mandatory live components that are also recorded
Reserved Classroom	YES	<b>YES</b> Instructors and/or students who have preference to be in-class may have this option if restrictions lifted	NO
