## Policy Statement (Intent and Scope)

As Chief Executive Officer of the University and the Board's sole employee, the President is *an ex-officio* non-voting member of the Board of Directors and its Committees.

In addition to the President, the Board appoints the following persons as e*x-officio* non-voting directors. They shall be entitled to attend and participate in all meetings of the Board, but shall remove themselves from any meeting in which they have a conflict of interest, as declared by the chair of the meeting, or when the Chair convenes a meeting of voting members as per Policy 1.2.1.

- 1. The President of King's University College Students' Council, or designate, as appointed by the Executive Council of Students' Council
- 2. Two (2) members of the faculty of the College as appointed by the Academic Council. As of April; 2025, any new nominees for these positions shall preferably be members of Academic Council;
- 3. One (1) member of non-academic staff of the College as appointed by the Academic Council;
- 4. One (1) professional officer of the College as appointed by the Academic Council; and
- 5. One (1) director of King's College Foundation as appointed by the Board of such corporation.

The Board will review this policy every three years.
