What is Cross-Cultural College?






















- ◆Run by KGU +4 Canadian universities

Certificate Program (CP)

The Certificate Program (CP) is a program that offers certificates to students from the operating 5 universities.

Students must take at least one course from Group C (Global Career Seminar or Global Internship), which is offered by KGU, and applicable courses from Groups A, B and D offered by their home universities.

Recruitment Information

Global Career Seminar is a 3 credit course where KGU and Canadian students work together to make business plans to solve the real business issues posed by the companies.

Queen's and King's: 62,000 yen



Requirements for Application



- Students are required to complete 2 semsesters of study at home university as of January 2023.
- Students must watch all the on-demand lectures and submit assignments stated in the syllabus.
- Students must attend all the synchronous sessions stated in the syllabus during "pre-lecture period" & in-person sessions at UofT.
- Withdrawals after official acceptance are not accepted without exceptional reasons and authorization from the Chief Academic Director at CCC Headquarters. Withdrawals will negatively affect the exchange balance as well as student's academic record.
