<p>Title page:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Title should be center aligned, a third of the way down the page. <input type="checkbox"/> Name, class information & date should follow after several lines. 	<p>In text citations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Author-Date system – in text <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ (Author, date) <input type="checkbox"/> Notes-Bibliography system – footnotes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Complete bibliographic citation
<p>General formatting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Entire document is double spaced except block quotation, table titles, figure captions & bibliographic entries. <input type="checkbox"/> Page numbers begin on the first page of the text, on the top right corner. <input type="checkbox"/> Times New Roman/Courier font in size 12 <input type="checkbox"/> Margins should be no less than 1 inch. <input type="checkbox"/> Titles in text: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Italicized: long titles of books, periodicals, poems and plays. ▪ Double quotations: short titles of articles, chapters and plays. 	<p>Bibliography/References:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Title is centered & without any effects (bold/italics/underline) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Page title ‘Bibliography’ for Notes-Bibliography system. ▪ Page title ‘References’ for Author-Date system. <input type="checkbox"/> Leave two lines between the page title and the first entry, and one line between every entry. <input type="checkbox"/> Listed in alphabetical order <input type="checkbox"/> Hanging indents for the first line of each citation
