

King's University College Recent Graduate Award

Recent Graduate Definition: King's University College has defined recent graduate as individuals who have graduated from King's within the past 15 years.

Selection Criteria

The Recent Graduate Award is presented annually, when merited, to one young alumna/us of King's University College in recognition of outstanding achievements.

These achievements will have earned them regional, national or international recognition or prominence through:

- service to humanity
- o their professions and/or volunteer organizations
- o community service
- o the advancement of knowledge, or
- o service to King's University College

Nominations

- To be eligible, the nominee must be a graduate of King's University College at The University of Western Ontario, London, Ontario, and consent to the nomination.
- The Recent Graduate Award is presented at the annual Homecoming festivities. The recipient must be in attendance to receive this award.
- Nominees must meet the definition of young alumni, as of the day of the award presentation.
- Current King's University Alumni Board Members are not eligible for nomination.

Putting forward a nomination

- To nominate a graduate for the Recent Graduate Award, please submit a personal letter of support explaining why your nominee should be recognized. The letter should address the accomplishments of the nominee as outlined in the selection criteria.
- Nominations will stand for 36 months. Alumni may be nominated posthumously, but a representative must be in attendance to accept the award on behalf of the recipient.
- Self-nominations will be accepted with a written letter of support from someone known to the nominee.

Selection Process

The Award Selection Committee will be formed to review and grade nominations. One recipient shall be chosen. However, in exceptional circumstances two recipients will be considered. The decision of the committee will be final.
