King's is located in the London, Ontario, the 11th largest city in Canada; just two hours from either Toronto or Detroit, Michigan. The campus is one block from Western University. Students can take courses at both campuses and can easily move between the two on a free shuttle bus or enjoy the short walk.

King's backs onto the beautiful Thames River, is adjacent to green space and is a short distance from the vibrant club, restaurant, arts and sports scene of downtown London.

Cultural diversity thrives at King's with students from every religious tradition, ethnicity, and every point of view. More than 10 per cent of students are international and come from over 35 different nations. Being

part of a community with cultures from all around the world allows students to connect globally right on campus. King's is also home of the Catholic chaplaincy team for Western; offering Catholic mass on campus and an active Campus Ministry team.

The quality of education at King's stands second to none. Degree programs are primarily liberal arts in areas such as Business, Accounting, Social Sciences, Arts, Childhood and Social Institutions, Social Justice and Peace Studies, and Social Work, as well as a Master's degree in Social Work. More than 97 per cent of King's students are employed in a field related to their studies within two years of graduation.

Renowned as a centre of teaching excellence, King's has received top grades from national student surveys on the quality of teaching and student/faculty interactions. With a student to faculty ratio of 21.3 to 1, students are able to request more one-on-one time with professors.

Residence is available for approximately 350 students and Student support services for academic or financial counselling are readily available. King's offers a generous scholarship and bursary program, and guarantees an Entrance Scholarship to high school students with final admission averages of 82 per cent or greater.

In January 2014, the three-story Daryl J. King Student Life Centre was opened, creating a new social and academic hub for the King's community.
