

How to Select your Fall/Winter 2021 Courses



Selecting your courses can be exciting and fun, if you tap into the right resources.

Go to www.kings.uwo.ca/courses-enrolment and explore the information and advice we have prepared for you. To narrow your course selection down, follow the steps below:

- 1** Check your **adjudication comments** on the Student Centre: My Academics > View My Grades > Grade Report. Next, check your **program** for which you are choosing courses: My Academics > My Program.
- 2** **Program Checklists** tell you what courses you need for your module/s. Check off the courses you've taken, and shortlist the ones you haven't taken. In general, please follow the program checklist for the year in which you entered your module. (Remember, electives are courses you can take in any subject area.)
- 3** Use the **Academic Calendar** to check prerequisites and antirequisites.
- 4** Check the **timetable** to see when the courses are offered and which ones fit your schedule. You must take at least 3.0 at King's if you are a full-time student; if a course is offered here, you **MUST** take it here.
- 5** Read these carefully: **course descriptions** and **course outlines**.
- 6** Wait for your online registration appointment, which will be posted to your Student Centre just before your appointment begins. Fall registration dates by year level: Year 4: July 5-9; Year 3: July 12-16; Year 2: July 19-23.
- 7** Log into the Student Center and under Western Links, click **Draft my Schedule** and create your draft schedule/s. Note: when your course registration appointment opens, you still need to add courses. Draft my Schedule is only a draft!
- 8** You are now ready to enroll in your classes! Go to www.student.uwo.ca > Enroll in classes.
