












# Course Types for Fall 2020

**Asynchronous:** something that can be viewed "on-demand". An example of this would be a recorded lecture, a YouTube video, or a Netflix movie.

**Synchronous:** Something that occurs at the same time or "live". An example of this would be a music concert, a class lecture delivered in-person or online at a specified date and time, or a scheduled TV show.

 <b>Timing of Delivery</b>	<b>Required*:</b> synchronous  <i>*Instructors may decide not to require attendance and/or explicit participation</i>	<b>Required*:</b> synchronous (i.e. students are required to keep timeslot reserved)  <i>*Instructors may decide to not require participation/attendance for all synchronous components. This will be clearly articulated in the course outline</i>	<b>Required*:</b> asynchronous <b>Optional:</b> synchronous components  <i>*Students are not committed to a specific day and time, but instructors may offer participation in non-mandatory live components that are also recorded</i>
 <b>Reserved Classroom</b>	<b>YES</b>	<b>YES</b>  <i>Instructors and/or students who have preference to be in-class may have this option if restrictions lifted</i>	<b>NO</b>

 <b>Office Hours</b>	Office hours take place in person and on campus	Office hours take place online	Office hours take place online
