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### STUDENT SUPPORT

**655** students had **Walk-In** appointments with Accessibility, Counselling and Student Development, an **increase of 65.8%** since the 2017/18 academic year

**93.75%** of students who completed our O-Week Survey reported that **King's Orientation Week** events help them **feel welcome and connected at King's**

**676** students with disabilities are registered with **Accessibility Services, a 50% increase** since the 2015/16 academic year

**19% decrease** in **"No-Show" Appointments** in Accessibility, Counselling and Student Development since the 2017/18 academic year

**827 international degree and exchange** students from **38 countries** represented at King's, a **15% increase** from the previous year

**111 students** went on, or were scheduled to go on, **International Faculty Led travel**
