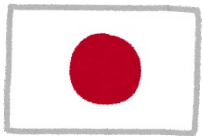

Certificate Program (CP)

The Certificate Program (CP) is a program that offers certificates to students from the operating 5 universities.

Students must take at least one course from Group C (Global Career Seminar or Global Internship), which is offered by KGU, and applicable courses from Groups A, B and D offered by their home universities.

12 pre-lectures (synchronous, asynchronous, and on-demand)
- **Intensive Lecture Period (Online Group Work Series) February 20-25, 2022**
6-day intensive sessions (synchronous)
- **Cross-cultural collaboration experience**
Students from KGU and Canadian universities work together remotely for cross-cultural exchange.

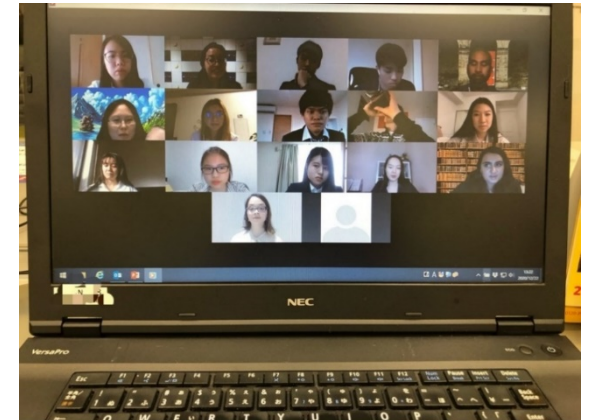

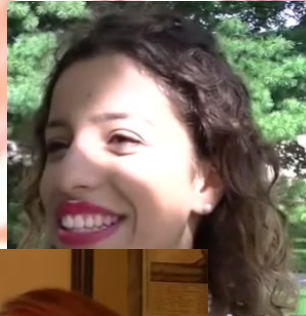
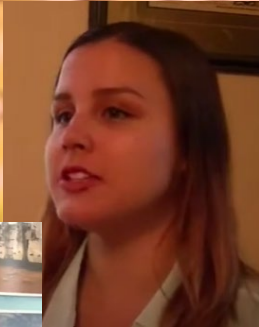

Requirements for Application

- Students are required to complete 2 semesters of study at home university as of January 31, 2022.
- Students must watch all the on-demand lectures and submit assignments stated in the syllabus.
- Students must attend all the synchronous sessions stated in the syllabus during “Pre-lecture Period (Online Individual Lecture Series)” & “Intensive Course Period (Online Group Work Series)”.
- Withdrawals after official acceptance are not accepted without exceptional reasons and authorization from the Chief Academic Director at CCC Headquarters. Withdrawals will negatively affect the exchange balance as well as students’ academic record.
