Language(s) of Teaching	Most courses are taught in French. Some are taught in English.
Credits Required	In the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), the normal workload for a full-time student is 30 credits per semester. 30 ECTS equal approximately 2.5 credits at King's/Western University.
