Who Can Apply?

The following criteria (with some exceptions) apply:

- Undergraduate students apply for exchange in second year and go abroad in third year.
- Students are selected based on academic achievement and potential as a King's ambassador.
- Successful candidates need a cumulative average of 70% or above and to be in good academic standing.
- Students are required to study full-time while on exchange.
