### To confirm your acceptance to residence accommodations, please follow these easy steps:

1. Ensure your Western Identity. You will need your Western/King's student number located in the right-hand corner of your academic offer letter. Please allow 24 hours before you proceed to Step 2.
2. Go to <https://mykings.ca/res-app> to complete your online application.
3. Pay a \$600 residence deposit to secure your residence placement.
4. You will receive an email to confirm that we have received your application and deposit. If you have not received confirmation within 2 weeks, please contact us at [Residence@kings.uwo.ca](mailto:Residence@kings.uwo.ca).
5. If you are under 18 years of age on the date you completed your application, you will need to provide the name and email address of a guarantor (parent or guardian) for the Residence Agreement. An email will be sent to the guarantor for approval.
