Student Choice Initiative and Other Optional Fees:

In January 2019 the Ontario Government announced the Student Choice Initiative which provides students the opportunity to opt out of non-mandatory ancillary fees. To complete an opt-out submission, please visit your student portal at <https://student.mykings.ca/sci> . The deadline to opt out of the non-mandatory fees is **September 25, 2019**.

First year students who wish to opt-out of the *Orientation Week* fee need to do so by **August 15th** through this portal.

Students who wish to opt-out of the *USC Health and/or Dental* plan need to do so at www.studentbenefits.ca.

OSAP:

The 2019-20 OSAP application is now available online at <https://osap.gov.on.ca/OSAPPortal/index.htm> . Students who intend on using OSAP funds to pay their fees for this upcoming September must complete the online application by **June 30th** and have all supporting documentation submitted by July 15th. Students can still apply after this date, however processing times can range from 6-8 weeks.

Hints when applying under the full-time program:

- You will be asked for your OAN (Ontario Access Number) and Password when logging in
 - If you have forgotten either of these, please visit https://osap.gov.on.ca/OSAPSecurityWeb/public/retrieve_oan.xhtml for assistance.
 - If you are still unable to retrieve your OAN and/or password, please come into Student Financial Services at King's (or any post-Secondary institution that administers OSAP) with your SIN card and valid government-issued photo ID. We can retrieve your OAN and/or issue a temporary password.
- Select Western University Canada as your institution and then select a King's program from the existing list.
