

SUMMER OSAP INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: Choose Your Summer Courses

Your summer enrolment must be finalized prior to applying for OSAP in the summer term.

Changes to your courses or course load after your application has been processed may impact your OSAP assessment/funding.

STEP 2: Determine If Your Course Load is Eligible for Full-Time or Part-Time OSAP

During the summer term (May to August 2024), your course load percentage must be at least 60% (or 40% as a student with a permanent disability) to be eligible for full-time OSAP.

For examples of a combined course load (multiple summer courses), please review the chart below. You may also contact Student Financial Services at <u>studentfinance@kings.uwo.ca</u> if you are unsure.
