### **COVID UPDATES: CAMPUS MINISTRY AND ONGOING PRECAUTIONS**

With the recent announcements from the Provincial government and the Diocese of London regarding changes to proof of vaccination requirements and other restrictions, there is a need to clarify the unique requirements of our community. Christ the King University Parish operates as facility of King's University and also has a unique location within the Chapel at Windermere on the Mount. We are bound by the policies of King's and committed to the safety of the residents at Windermere as we interpret the guidelines for worship from the Diocese of London.

The main change at this time is capacity. More spaces are available in Eventbrite to reflect this. We will gradually add some ministries that have been dormant during the past several months including Eucharistic ministers, additional readers, music ministry (choirs), and servers. If all goes well, we are looking forward to a full and joyful celebration of Easter!

**VACCINATION** is still required for all who are participating in gatherings of our community (events, mass, trips, retreats etc.) according to the policy of the University of Western and its affiliates. If you come to campus, you may still be required to show proof of vaccination.

**REGISTRATION** remains a requirement for in-person programming. This includes a declaration of your vaccination status. Walk-ins are welcome but will be screened at the door.

**MASKS** are required at all times unless you are eating.



**SELF SCREENING** continues. We are still in a pandemic and we rely on you to stay home if you are unwell. Please read the signs at the entrances and consult with staff if you are unsure.

**ACCESS** to the Chapel at Windermere on the Mount is still restricted. All visitors must continue to use the side entrance until the visitor policy changes for the retirement home.
