THE ABRAHAMIC PEACE GARDEN

Located at King's University College, the Abrahamic Garden or as London Interfaith Peace Camp likes to refer to it as "the Peace Garden" is the place where LIPC spends much time reflecting on each of the individual faith traditions as well as cultivating and caring for our own section. In the summer of 2022, King's offered a section of the garden to LIPC. During camp week, campers in grades 1-3 were able to plant and care for new annuals and perennials in the garden.



We also celebrated the installation of the "Peace Pole" from LIPC 2019, the last year of in-person camp before the pandemic. The theme of the peace pole (as well as LIPC 2019) was Generation-to-Generation, focusing on the shared history of our faiths as well as the importance of family connection and history.

This July, the London Interfaith Peace Camp family invites you to be a part of the growing garden at King's University College.


On July 30th 2023, we will be hosting a planting party! Come for a visit and assist in preparing our gardens!
