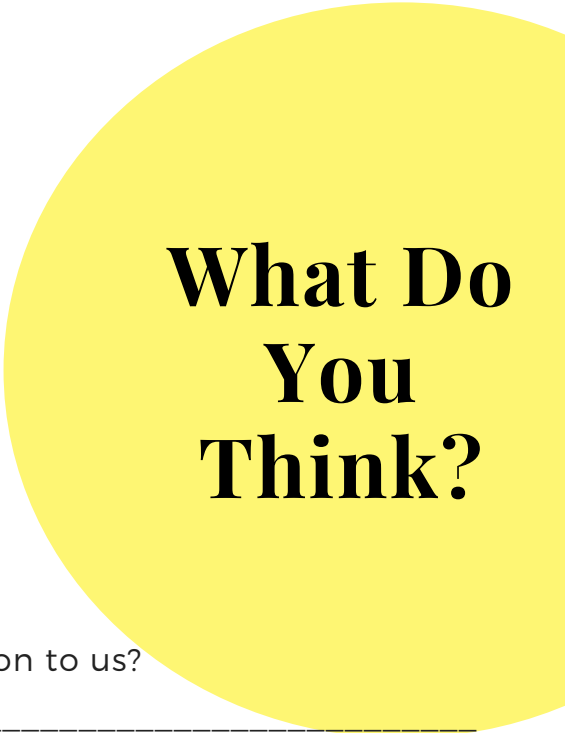


Gospel: John 15:9-14
