1. Talk about the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. How do different people use these gifts?

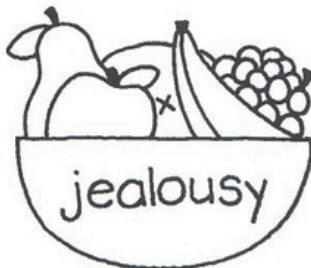
2. How do you recognize the presence of the Spirit in your life?
