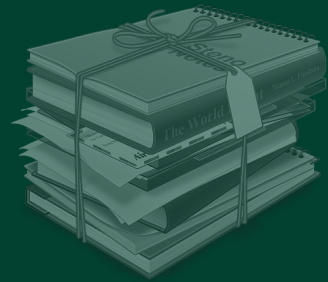


# KING'S TRENDS 2015/2016

**227**

The amount of students who received counselling support for counselling services; an **increase of 13%** over 2014/15.

An increase of accommodated testing for students with disabilities from 2217 tests/exams to 2306. This represents a **4% increase** over last year.



**452**

The amount of students who received accommodation for disabilities (primarily psychiatric and learning disabilities); an **increase of 10%** over 2014/15. **100** students from Western/Brescia/Huron also required accommodation.

RTW/AP study done in summer 2015 showed that students with disabilities were not over-represented as being on academic probation or required to withdraw status.



## LEARNING SKILLS

Learning Skills saw a participation increase of 40% in group programming and a 123% increase in individual appointments. However, still represents a fraction of students needing support.



There was a significant decrease in the overall number of incidents in residence, from 106 to 72. This was a decrease of 33% overall.

## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS



This year, King's International welcomed 519 international and 36 exchange students from over 30 countries. This was an increase of 13.2% over 2014/15.

There was an increase of 6 incidents involving the Code of Conduct in 2015/2016.

The amount of career counselling appointments in 2015/2016.



KAMP received 89 applications, hired 48 mentors, and paired 222 mentees with mentors.

Students received recognition for their involvement on their co-curricular record.
