## **SUMMER OSAP DEADLINES**

The deadline to apply and submit all supporting documentation for **both** full time and part time OSAP for the summer term is 6 weeks (42 days) prior to the end of <u>your</u> study period (including published exam period). If you are only taking a **3-week course** you must apply and submit all supporting documentation 3 weeks prior to the course start date. To defer your tuition payment, your application must be submitted by **April 3rd, 2023**
