Within the nine members:

- Five Research Discipline Experts: To ensure comprehensive disciplinary expertise King's Research Ethics Review Committee (RERC) distributes disciplinary representation as follows: one from the Department of Psychology, one from school of Social Work, one representing Arts and Humanities academic units, and two representing Social Science academic units (other than Psychology and Social Work)

- * Two Community Members (not currently affiliated with King's)
- One Legal Expert (not King's legal counsel)
- * * One Student Member (selected by the student members of Faculty Council)
- * * One King's College Community member (staff or professional officer)
